



## Case History

### 17 day turnaround for Travis Perkins

One of the UK's largest building material suppliers, Travis Perkins, called upon their local Rainbow branch late one evening. They had suffered up to 3 feet of flood water entering and contaminating their premises and stock due to the River Caens bursting it's banks causing localised flooding.

This resulted in mud deposits and contamination affecting 8 areas of the site including the entire shop, office, wood store and courtyards.

Rainbow's branch in Newton Abbot attended site to remove all water, silt, debris and contaminated materials, to allow for the premises to be returned to pre-incident condition.

They project managed the entire restoration process for Travis Perkins which included drying, strip out work, sanitising, cleaning, Ultrasonic cleaning, removal of items beyond economic restoration as well as redecoration. Rainbow arranged for a Portakabin to be delivered to site, to allow for a temporary administration suite on-site.

Due to the hard work and dedication of Rainbow's staff the site was back to its pre-incident condition in only 17 days.
